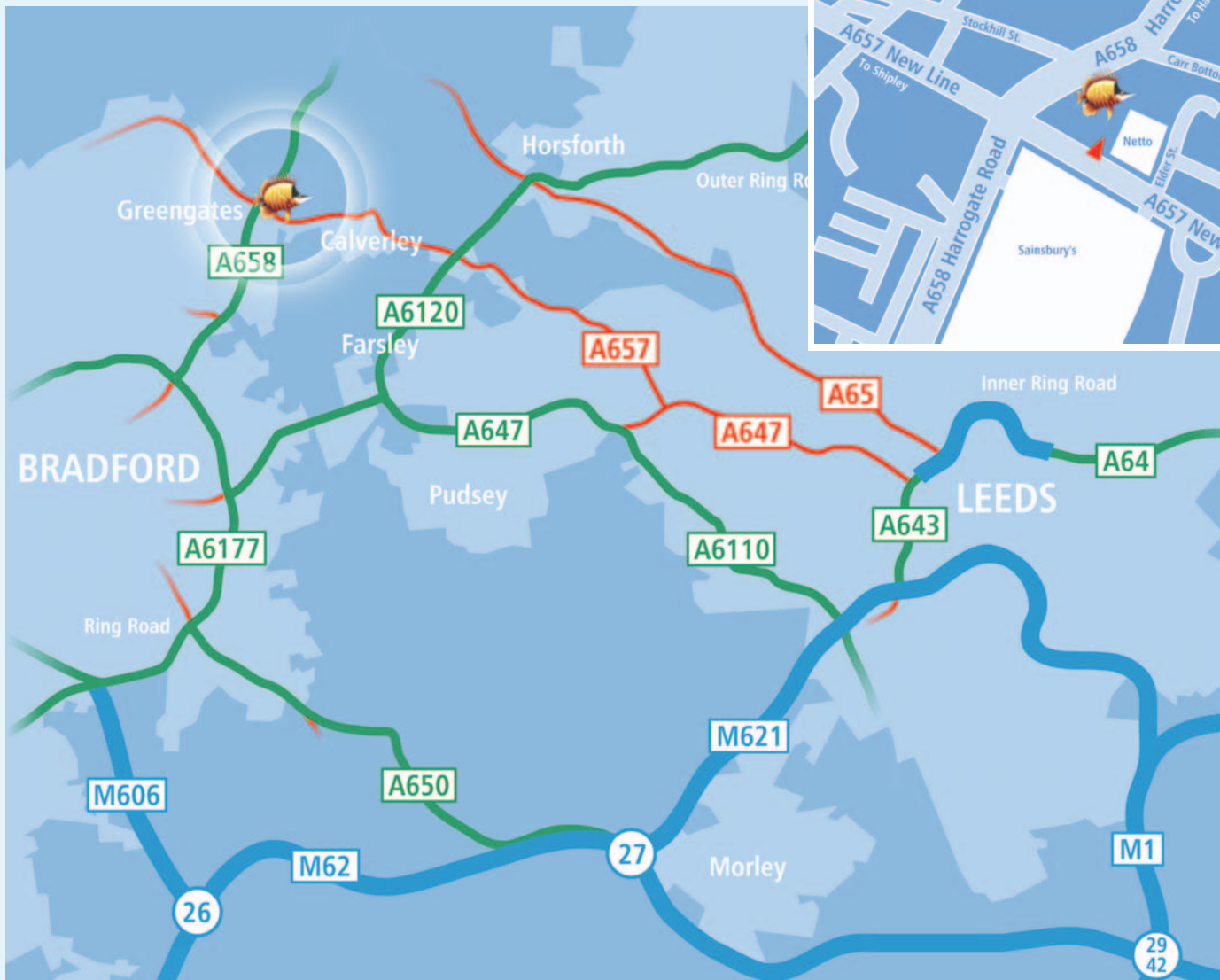


How to get to Seamless...



Northbound from the M1

At J42, take the slip road to join the M62 (J29), heading west towards Manchester.

Continue straight ahead on the M62.

When you reach J27, exit the M62 and at the roundabout, take the first exit onto A650.

Continue straight ahead along the A650 until you reach the Bradford Ring Road (A6177).

At the roundabout, take the third exit onto A6177 Sticker Lane. Continue straight ahead onto Killinghall Road.

Turn right onto A658 Harrogate Road.

Continue along this road until you see Sainsbury's on your right and The Roebuck public house on your left.

At the junction with the A657 turn right at the traffic lights towards Leeds.

Immediately after this, turn left into the car park for the Netto supermarket and drive through the gates located at the rear and to the left.

Eastbound from the M62

Leave the M62 at J26 and take the M606, signposted Bradford.

Continue along the M606.

At the next roundabout, take the fifth exit onto A6177 Rooley Lane, and continue straight ahead onto Killinghall Road.

Turn right onto A658 Harrogate Road.

Continue along this road until you see Sainsbury's on your right and The Roebuck public house on your left.

At the junction with the A657, turn right at the traffic lights towards Leeds.

Immediately after this, turn left into the car park for the Netto supermarket and drive through the gates located at the rear and to the left.

Southbound from the A1(M)

Exit the A1(M) at J47, and at the roundabout, take the third exit on to the A59.

Continue along the A59 until you reach the roundabout and take the second exit onto the A658.

Continue along the A658 for approximately 18 miles, past Leeds Bradford International Airport, through Yeadon and Apperley Bridge, until you reach the junction with the A657, with the Seven Stars public house on your right.

At the traffic lights, turn left towards Leeds.

Immediately after this, turn left into the car park for the Netto supermarket and drive through the gates located at the rear and to the left.
